# Khopra Danda Trek

## **Trip Overview**

Khopra Danda Trek is the perfect gateway if you want to escape the crowded route and the popular trail of Annapurna range but still want to capture the magnificent panoramic view of Annapurna range up close. The trek to Khopra Danda not only offers you the glorious view of the Annapurna South and Dhaulagiri with an adventurous option to ascend to a high-altitude lake and get even more splendid views of the Annapurna range. The Himalayas of Nepal are popular among the trekkers, therefore, through trekking not only they are able to get the awesome views of the Himalayas, nevertheless, but it has also opened an opportunity to know the local culture, tradition, and the diverse community of Nepal. Khopra Danda Trek is more of a teahouse trek. Few numbers of teahouses or lodges can be found on the trail. Since the place is a less frequently traveled destination so finding luxury accommodation is difficult. However, staying at community lodges or teahouses run by the residents make the trail more memorable and enjoyable. More importantly, they are cheaper and fit easily into the budget of any trekker planning to visit Khopra Danda Trek. Furthermore, the trail is exciting as you will be walking through the lush forest of Rhododendron swallowing the views of the rivers flowing down the trail. As you will reach the ridge, the viewpoint, the sight from there is mesmerizing and splendid.

Khopra Danda Trek can be taken as an alternative trekking destination if you are not keen to crowd. Besides that, it is the best substitute for Annapurna Panoramic Trek and Annapurna Sanctuary Trek. The Khopra Danda Trek also includes an amazing sightseeing tour of UNESCO-listed world heritage sites of Kathmandu valley. The official trek begins from Ghorepani which is another viewpoint for views of stunning mountains and ends at Tadapani, a charming village operating guesthouses and lodges.
