

Annapurna North Base Camp Trek

Trip Overview

Annapurna North Base Camp Trek has fewer travelers and is full of wilderness. Nepal trekking trails for the trekking lover are quite fascinating, as the unique landscapes never fail to amaze them. Nevertheless, the trail of the Annapurna North Base Camp is difficult but at the same time thrilling and exciting. Annapurna North Base Camp is a remote and less popular trekking trail, but nowadays it is gaining attention among adventure trekkers due to its wild beauty.

The route was first completed by Maurice Herzog in 1950. The northwest view is flawlessly seen on the trail from Mirisati Khola to Annapurna North Base Camp. The view is mesmerizing, with shimmering glaciers, mountains, glimmering high mountains, and a deep valley. The magnificent view of the Annapurna North Base Camp, Nilgiri, Tilicho Peak, and the grand Annapurna range from the first French base camp is a fantastic sight to see.

The trek to the Annapurna base camp is different from other trekking trails in the Annapurna range. Thus, trekking through this trail is mainly for adventure seekers and will give you a different feel than trekking in Nepal. Trip Itinerary

Day 1: Pick up from airport transfer to Hotel

Cost Includes

- 3-star hotel accommodation in Kathmandu with breakfast (hotel standard will be changed as you wish)

- Domestic flights as per the itinerary.
- Breakfast, lunch, and dinner during the trek.
- An experienced, English-speaking, and government-licensed trekking guide.
- Porter Service trekking crew, including their salary, insurance, equipment, domestic airfare, food, and accommodation.
- Highland Eco's duffel bag.
- All necessary paperwork and trekking permits (Permit ACAP, Conservation fee, TIMS).
- A first-aid safety kit with basic medicines is essential.
- All government and local taxes and fees.

Cost Excludes

- Nepal Entry visa fees
- Extra-night accommodation in Kathmandu because of early arrival, late departure, or early return from the mountain (due to any reason) compared to the scheduled itinerary
- Lunch and evening meals in Kathmandu
- International flights
- Personal trekking equipment, which is not provided by Highland Eco
- Travel and rescue insurance
- Tips to the guide, porter, driver, or any other trekking staff
